



VOLODYMYR KYRYCHENKO

(17.06.1942 – 02.04.2019)

Volodymyr Kyrychenko has gone on April 2, 2019.

Student of A. V. Roiter and D. K. Faddeev, Volodymyr Kyrychenko was among the pioneers of the Kyiv school of the Theory of Representations and significantly contributed in its forming and achievements. His papers on lattices and orders, on serial and semidistributive rings has become classical in these areas. His book “Finite Dimensional Algebras” (with Yuriy Drozd) remains number one both as a manual for students and as a monograph. His trilogy “Algebras, Rings and Modules” (with Nadya Gubareni and Michiel Hazewinkel) has gained wide popularity.

More than 50 years Volodymyr Kyrychenko was working at the Department of Mathematics of the Kyiv National Taras Shevchenko University, first at the Division of Algebra and Mathematical Logic, then at the Division of Geometry and Topology, where he was the chairman. His lectures were always scientifically deep and at the same time quite clear and comprehensible. A lot of his students has become known mathematicians and highly appreciate Volodymyr Kyrychenko as their teacher and advisor.

Volodymyr Kyrychenko was playing an important role as an organizer of the mathematical life in Ukraine. He was an initiator of the biennial International Algebraic Conferences in Ukraine, one of the founders and editors of the journal “Algebra and Discrete Mathematics”.

His colleagues, students and the whole Ukrainian mathematical community grieve over his death and deeply sympathize his family and relatives. We will always miss Volodymyr Kyrychenko.
